BELGRAVE SQUARE TENNIS COURT RULES

1. **Membership Eligibility**

Membership is available to all keyholders from buildings in Belgrave Square and all Belgrave Square Garden keyholders who live in Belgravia.

In the case of Embassy and Institutional premises in Belgrave Square, each Embassy or Institutional user may nominate up to four responsible adults for the purpose of Membership.

In the case of a family, up to four members of the immediate family - ie husband, wife, children - may play.

2. **Court Bookings**

Bookings may be made for **one hour's play** per family, Embassy or Institution during the course of each day. If there is no-one waiting to play at the end of that hour, play may continue for additional time.

The Court may only be booked by a Member.

Bookings must be made through the online tennis court booking system:

If you do not have access to the internet, you can make or cancel a booking by calling 020 7312 0011 between 09.30 and 16.30 Monday-Friday. You will need to provide your member ID.

Bookings can be made up to three days in advance.

A Member may **NOT** book the Court for his guests alone.

If the Court is booked for Junior Members (under the age of 14) they must be accompanied by an adult.

3. **Payment for the Use of the Tennis Court**

An annual fee is payable by each Embassy, Institution or Garden Member wishing to use the Tennis Court. This fee covers the use of the Court by the four nominated Members in the case of an Embassy or Institution. In the case of a Garden Member, the fee covers the use of the Court by four members of the family. The cost is £194.35 (outside Belgrave Square) or £93.15 (inside Belgrave Square) as at 3 May 2009.

Should a key be lost, a written application to the Grosvenor Office will be considered for a replacement key, for which a nominal charge of £39 plus VAT will be payable.

4. **Guests**

In order to ensure that the Court is available for the use of Members for the maximum time, individual guests may only be invited to play on three occasions in each subscription year - ie from 31 May to 30 May.

5. **Shoes**

Tennis shoes must be worn on the Court.

6. **Weather**

The Court must not be used if there is any danger that damage may result due to recent rain, frost, etc.
